Jürgen Scheffran is professor at the Institute of Geography of University of Hamburg and head of the Research Group Climate Change and Security (CLISEC) in the Excellence Initiative "Integrated Climate Systems Analysis and Prediction" (CliSAP) at KlimaCampus Hamburg. He is Associate Member of the Center for Science and Peace Research (ZNF) and Faculty Affiliate of the Program in Arms Control, Disarmament and International Security (ACDIS) at the University of Illinois. After his physics Ph.D. at the University of Marburg he worked in the Interdisciplinary Research Group IANUS and the Mathematics Department of the Technical University of Darmstadt, at the Potsdam Institute for Climate Impact Research (PIK), and he spent five years at the University of Illinois at Urbana-Champaign. His research and teaching interests include: energy security, climate change and sustainability science; complex systems analysis, mathematical modeling and computer simulation; technology assessment, arms control and international security.
